The RPS Guidebook, Ninth Edition, requires LSEs to use the new RPS Online System for RPS annual verification reporting. The RPS Online System is the platform for submitting WREGIS Reports and Attestations, and for local publicly owned electric utilities (POUs), to submit Annual Summary Reports, contracts, e-Tag Reports, and Hourly Reports. RPS Verification staff will present and demonstrate the following:

- Overall annual verification reporting requirements and deadlines
- LSE reporting, applicable to all retail sellers and POUs, on how to submit and attest to a WREGIS Report
- POU-only reporting, on how to enter, upload, attest to and submit a POU Annual Summary Report, contracts, e-Tag Reports, and Hourly Reports
