The *Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPS) Eligibility Guidebook, Ninth Edition (Revised)* was adopted by the Energy Commission at its scheduled business meeting on April 27, 2017. The *RPS Guidebook* describes the eligibility requirements and processes for certifying renewable resources as eligible for California's RPS and describes how the Energy Commission will track and verify compliance with the RPS. The *RPS Eligibility Guidebook, Ninth Edition (Revised)* incorporates non-substantive changes to the *RPS Eligibility Guidebook, Ninth Edition* adopted at the January 25, 2017, Business Meeting to correct typographical errors, update an incomplete URL, remove an obsolete table reference, and remove obsolete formatting codes.
