Subject: Modified Deadlines for Air Quality Testimony and a Note About Citations to Documents

Air Quality Testimony. During the March 4, 2015, Status Conference, Dr. Steven Moore, representing the San Diego Air Pollution Control District, indicated that the District's Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC) would be filed by March 13, 2015. That date is after the deadline for the submission of direct testimony (March 10) established by the Committee.

Following a discussion with the parties, I indicated that the deadline for direct Air Quality testimony would be revised as follows: on or before March 10, the parties will file all of the direct Air Quality testimony that they are capable of submitting at that time. On or before March 24, the parties will submit any additional direct Air Quality testimony and rebuttal testimony on all topics. This limited extension will allow the parties to review the FDOC before filing their final Air Quality testimony.

Remember that if you file additional direct Air Quality or rebuttal testimony, you must also file a revised exhibit list.

Citing to Documents. Some of the document exhibits you will be citing have no page numbers or will be a compilation of several documents with each beginning at page 1. In those cases, please include the page number in the docketed .pdf file in your citation to a specific portion of the document. For example, page 2 of the Carlsbad City Manager's testimony in recently filed TN 203771 is found at page 10 of the 175 page posted.pdf file. Note that the posted (docketed) copy will have one more page than the copy you uploaded due to the addition of the docket stamp at the beginning of the file.
