
Pomona Repower Project – Overview

- Acquired by AltaGas in January 2015
 - Existing San Gabriel Cogeneration Facility is 44.5 MW
 - Located at 1507 Mt. Vernon Avenue (site of the old paper mill) on 2-acre parcel
- Proposed 100-MW natural-gas-fired, simple-cycle (peaking) facility and removal of the San Gabriel Facility currently in operation
- Demolition expected to take ~3 months
- Construction expected to take ~16 months
 - Up to 140 construction jobs
- Commissioning 1st Quarter 2019
- Property taxes are estimated to increase by ~\$1.1 million annually
- Use existing 66 kV Simpson transmission line connected to SCE's Ganesha-Simpson transmission line

Pomona Repower Project – Overview

- Primary water source will switch from potable to recycled water
 - Will provide a use for City's excess recycled water
 - PRP will use ~22 percent of the current facility's daily potable water consumption, while producing more than twice the electrical output
- Key project components
 - One (1) GE LMS100PA combustion turbine generator
 - Evaporative coolers on inlet air system, compressor inter-stage cooling and water injection to control NOx
 - One (1) multifan, induced draft cooling tower
 - Two (2) fuel gas compressors, new gas compressor/pressure control station
 - One (1) raw water storage tank
 - One (1) 66-kV interconnection to the Ganesha Simpson transmission line
 - Reuse existing supply and discharge lines, including natural gas, potable and recycled water, process wastewater and sanitary wastewater.


Pomona Repower Project Site Layout









West and East Elevations






North and South Elevations


