### **Background**

The California Energy Commission will hold a 2017 pre-rule making staff workshop for the 2019 Standards update that will include a presentation and discussion of proposed residential Heating Ventilation and Cooling (HVAC) measures. Specific HVAC measures include residential quality HVAC and small duct high velocity systems. This workshop will also include a presentation and discussion of proposed changes to the Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider (ATTCP) requirements.
