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Cost effectiveness analysis should include all costs of supplying gas

In the cost-effectiveness analysis of mixed fuel vs all-electric, all costs of bringing gas service to a home must be included. Such costs include utility company-assessed administrative costs as well as both labor and materials associated with trenching, piping to the home, meter installation, piping within the home, venting (including both combustion make-up air and flue gas), and CO alarms.
