### **International Window Film Comments on the Draft Title 24, Part 6 Standards**

The International Window Film Association (IWFA) is a unified industry body of window film dealers, distributors, and manufacturers that has been the third-party industry source for accurate technical information on window film products and its uses for several decades. IWFA appreciates the opportunity to provide input on the 2019 Standards Rulemaking.

IWFA would like to request that CEC staff update Residential Appendix 4.2.2.3 and Nonresidential Appendix 7.4.2.4 to update the warranty requirements from a 10-year Warranty Certificate to a 15-year Warranty Certificate. The reason for this request is to reflect the current market practice where the vast majority of window film products are now supported with a 15-year or longer Warranty Certificate. IWFA will provide documentation to the CEC to support current market window film warranties.
