Following the Committee Closed Session today, the Committee announced that:

- 1. Terramar Association's motion to have Exhibit 3045 admitted into evidence is GRANTED because no party objects, the document was timely docketed, clearly intended to be testimony, and inadvertently omitted from Terramar's exhibit list.
- 2. Carlsbad Energy Center's motion to have Exhibits 1032 through 1051 (Caltrans' FEIR/FEIS for the I-5 widening) admitted into evidence is also GRANTED. Although docketed at the end of the briefing period, the EIR/EIS has been publicly available for at least a year. It was mentioned in the testimony of several parties, including staff, who cited it as a reference (Exhibit 2000, p. 4.13-49). The EIR/EIS is clearly relevant to a visual resources issue before us.
- 3. No further written orders will be issued regarding the above motions.
- 4. The Evidentiary Record is now closed.
