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Water as Eligible Feedstock

I notice that nowhere in the list of eligible feedstocks is water mentioned. Are you intentionally excluding electrolysis of water under this solicitation?

Eligible sources of electricity to power the electrolysis process are already well-articulated in the second paragraph of Section 6 "ELIGIBLE FEEDSTOCKS AND RENEWABLE ELECTRICITY SOURCES (Draft Solicitation; top of page 6). Just as these renewable electricity sources must also power bio-digesters and other waste fuel conversion processes. One must consider "feedstocks" as the actual source of the H₂. Where is the molecule coming from? In the case of waste fuels, its coming from the methane (CH₄) in those fuels. Just as in electrolysis, its coming from the H₂O, not the kilowatts that crack H₂O.
