
**Project Description:** MLGS is an 760-megawatt simple-cycle natural gas fired power plant. The project started commercial operation in May, 2013.

**Modification Description:** MLGS proposes installation of a new diesel backup generator, a diesel fire pump engine and 150 feet of fire loop piping. MLGS formerly used a neighboring facility's fire suppression system, that system is no longer maintained. Staff proposes five new air quality (AQ) conditions of certification (COCs) (**AQ-41, AQ-42, AQ-43, AQ-44, AQ-45**) addressing diesel engine operation and monitoring, and modification of one existing AQ COC (**AQ-SC7**) and one biological resources (BIO) COC (**BIO-8**) requiring surrender of additional emission reduction credits and increased annual mitigation payments to offset a slight nitrogen deposition increase.

On November 17, 2014, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project changes pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.

1. With mitigation, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made conditions of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (LORS); and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
