**NOTICE OF RECEIPT  
PETITION TO AMEND  
THE CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION DECISION FOR THE  
ORANGE GROVE POWER PROJECT (08-AFC-4C)**

On April 11, 2016, Orange Grove Energy, L.P. filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to modify the Final Decision for the Orange Grove Power Project (OGPP). The simple-cycle, natural gas-fired, electricity-generating, 96-megawatt facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision on April 8, 2009, and began operation on June 17, 2010. The facility is located in the unincorporated area of Pala, in San Diego County, California.

**DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION**

The proposed modification would allow the installation of like-kind replacement of some components of the emission control systems at the OGPP. The objective of the proposed work is to restore worn parts of the emission control systems and to optimize the design of system components using like-kind part replacement where needed to improve resistance to wear and long-term reliability of the emission control systems, and to improve reliability.

**ENERGY COMMISSION AMENDMENT REVIEW PROCEDURES**

Energy Commission staff is currently reviewing the petition. The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality and on public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and a determination on whether the facility, as modified, would remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (20 Cal. Code of Regs., § 1769). Upon completion of its review, the staff will provide written notice of its intent to either process the proposed changes as a Staff Approved Project Modification or schedule it for consideration by the Energy Commission at a regularly scheduled Business Meeting.

This Notice of Receipt has been mailed to the Commission's facility mail list of interested parties and property owners adjacent to the facility site. It has also been e-mailed to the facility listserv. The listserv is an automated Energy Commission e-mail system by which information about this facility is e-mailed to parties who have subscribed. To subscribe, go to the Commission's webpage for this facility, cited above,

scroll down on the right side of the project's webpage to the box labeled "Subscribe," and provide the requested contact information.

Any person may comment on the petition.
