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## **HECA Plant**

To Whom It May Concern,

I am unable to attend the public meeting tonight but would like to voice my opposition to the proposed HECA plant. My foremost opposition is based on the route the delivery trucks will take along Enos Lane. I travel Enos Lane twice daily and it is a slow route due to the numerous delivery trucks and farm vehicles that currently use this road. If you allow the HECA delivery vehicles to use this same two-lane road up to 450 trips per day, it will have the effect of slowing down the traffic to a stand still. Within the past year, a major accident occurred on Highway 5, forcing traffic to be routed along Enos Lane. On that day, traffic was at a standstill. If the HECA plant is allowed to use Enos Lane daily, we will have a similar traffic congestion problem that does not go away with the clearing of an accident.

Secondly, I'm not sure who would consider approving this route knowing that 450 truckloads of coal and waste would be traveling within feet of a school district that houses 1000 plus students a day but there is no legitimate argument to be made that the health of those students will not be affected by this increase in air pollution.

For the safety of the students at Rio Bravo Greeley School District and the traffic along a rural two lane route, this plant should not be allowed to open at it's proposed site.
