<u>Section 6 and 10</u>: CEC and the Department require a final description of pipeline crossing installation methods. Please provide additional details regarding horizontal directional drilling, including but not limited to the depth and length of the boring and whether drilling fluids will be used.

The Notification includes water bodies that are not jurisdictional and can be removed from the Project description.
