I'm writing this letter to show my support for the Hydrogen Energy California project. I was born and raised in Kern County and I am proud of the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution and Control District and the Kern County Planning Commission for helping this project move along. Our local air control district found that HECA will have no significant impacts to the health of our residents or nearby crops, effectively disproving the arguments of people opposed to the project with legitimate proof.

I believe that HECA's opposition has exaggerated the number of trucks that will be on Kern County roads because of the plant. HECA has been consistent in reporting the number of trucks that will be on the roads if approved but the opposition keeps throwing out random numbers. It really doesn't make any sense.

Recently, HECA requested a cancellation of land from the Williamson Act to build a rail spur that would potentially help mitigate heavier traffic levels.
