

Dear Mr. Blevins:

On August 10, and Aug 13, we submitted to you a CEC-SEP-4 Application on behalf of CalRENEW-1, LLC., as well as an Application for Confidential Designation of certain information that is part of the CEC-SEP-4 Application. Cleantech America Inc. now seeks to withdraw these Applications and their attendant materials.

The withdrawal of these Applications is predicated on the advice of CEC and CPUC staff regarding the recent passage of SB 1036, and the understanding from the CEC that the SEP program will be terminated by the CEC, such that above-market costs for RPS projects, such as CalRENEW-1, will be reviewed by the CPUC and recovered from the utility buyer.
