REVISED COMMITTEE SCHEDULING ORDER

Background

On July 31, 2008, Hydrogen Energy International, LLC (HEI) filed an Application for Certification (AFC) seeking authority to construct and operate the Hydrogen Energy California Project (HECA), an integrated gasification combined cycle (IGCC) power generating facility rated at a nominal gross generating capacity of 390 megawatts (MW). To avoid conflict with habitat for endangered species, HEI retracted the original AFC and filed a revised application on May 28, 2009, for the same project to be built at a different location. An Informational Hearing and a Site Visit were conducted on September 16, 2009. The proposed HECA would be located near the unincorporated community of Tupman in western Kern County, California, seven miles west of the city limit of Bakersfield.

SCS Energy California, LLC acquired 100 percent ownership of HECA, LLC in September 2011, undertook the re-design of some aspects of the project, and submitted an amended AFC in May 2012. The Energy Commission assigned a Committee of two Commissioners to conduct proceedings on the AFC. The Committee held a Public Site Visit and Informational Hearing at the Elk Hills School in Tupman on July 12, 2012, to discuss the amended AFC, the Energy Commission review process and to identify issues that could affect the schedule. Pursuant to Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations, section 1709.7(c), the Committee issued a Scheduling Order based on Staff's proposed schedule and related discussions at the Informational Hearing. Staff issued the Preliminary Staff Assessment/Draft Environmental Impact Statement (PSA/DEIS) on June 28, 2013.

The attached revised schedule is based upon information submitted by the parties in recent status reports and discussion which took place during the November 2013 Committee Conference on the PSA/DEIS. Commission staff's November 2013 status report emphasized the numerous areas of information requested by staff and not yet received from the applicant. According to staff, a publication date for the Final Staff

Assessment (FSA) at the end of March 2014 would allow adequate time for the information to be provided and incorporated into the FSA.

Applicant proposed a significantly earlier publication date for the FSA. Given the complexity and relative novelty of many aspects of this project, we understand staff's concerns about the necessity for complete information before the FSA can be published.

Status Reports and Status Conferences

The attached schedule requires status reports to be submitted by all parties. Status reports shall inform the Committee whether or not case development is progressing satisfactorily and bring potential schedule delays and other relevant matters to the Committee's attention. In addition, the Committee may schedule one or more status conferences to discuss any issues that may arise.

Each party's status report must be uploaded to the Energy Commission e-filing system or received by the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS-4, Sacramento, California 95814-5512 **no later than 3:00 p.m.** on the due date. Status reports must contain "Docket No. 08-AFC-08A" in the caption or heading.

Public Adviser and Public Participation

The Energy Commission invites members of the public and other interested parties to participate either on an informal basis or by intervening in the proceeding. Both types of participation allow written and oral comments. At the informal participation level, written and oral public comments are considered by the Commissioners and are part of the record, but are not part of the formal evidentiary record. Intervenors have the right to introduce evidence into the evidentiary record and cross-examine the other parties' witnesses.
