RE: Local mitigation requests to C.E.C. regarding Hydrogen Energy California

To Whom It May Concern:

Kern County residents have requested I convey their list of mitigation requests to minimize the impact of Hydrogen Energy California (HECA).

1. Support evaluation of alternative sites as suggested by the Kern County Board of Supervisors.
2. Provide air monitors to the two local school districts and tie that monitoring to the San Joaquin Air Pollution Control District's real time advisory.
3. Honor the Kern County Farm Bureau's request for a bond for any potential damage to farms, crops, or land.
4. Mandate disclosure of the worst case scenario of accidental release of an entire tank of anhydrous ammonia. How far would contamination extend in mile radius?

I ask that the California Energy Commission include each of the stated mitigation requests in the approval process.
