Attached are the names of 6,982 Californians, who together submit the following comment in support of Sierra Club and other intervenor's motion to terminate this proceeding.

Subject: Terminate the proceeding reviewing the Hydrogen Energy California project

Dear California Energy Commission,

I'm writing to urge the California Energy Commission ("CEC") to terminate the proceeding reviewing the Hydrogen Energy California project. For more than a year, the developer has failed to respond to staff inquiries for more information about water use, greenhouse gas pollution and more.

California is in the midst of the worst drought in state history. We simply cannot afford to hand over 7,500 acre feet of water every year when that water could provide critical supply to local farmers. Furthermore, without a clear and enforceable agreement to sequester the greenhouse gas pollution, the project cannot be built according to state law.

The time has come to close the book on this dirty and dangerous proposal. The developer either cannot resolve these critical issues and/or has ceased efforts to address them. I therefore urge the CEC to terminate the proceeding and prioritize other projects that can move the state in the direction of a truly clean energy future.
