Sami called me in response to our letter request on September 30, 2015, for a Water Supply Assessment (WSA) for the Palmdale Energy Project (PEP) potable water supply. Sami said the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works will do a WSA for the PEP potable water supply. Sami asked that I provide him with information about the PEP project and the water supply information in particular. I told Sami I would get him the information by noon today. Sam estimated that the WSA would take two to three weeks to complete, but that estimate could change depending on his review of the work involved in completing the WSA. Sami told me that after he has reviewed all of the information, he could give me a fairly solid date for when the WSA would be done.

After Sami reviewed the information I provided above, he called back the same day and said he could complete the WSA in two to three weeks, with a week review time. Then it would take another five to six weeks for their Board to review and approve the WSA.
