<u>Modification Description</u>: On July 20, 2015, Palmdale Energy LLC submitted a Petition to Amend the previously approved Palmdale Hybrid Power Project. On August 9, 2017, the Energy Commission approved the Petition to Amend with a Final Decision.

This Committee-assigned amendment to the previously approved Palmdale Hybrid Power Project changes the project to a natural-gas-fired combined-cycle power plant with an approximate net output of 699.4 MW. The approval reduces the site to 50 acres, eliminates the solar component, and replaces the combustion turbine technology with fast start flexible technology.

The California Energy Commission approved the above-described project pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.

- 1. With mitigation, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
- 2. Mitigation measures were made conditions of approval of the project;
- 3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (LORS); and
- 4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
