Over the last two years, the large success of the California renewables and energy efficiency programs, notwithstanding the slow recovery to our economy, have markedly slowed the need for new generation in Northern California. While we remain committed to the development of our Project in Vacaville, we also recognize that the need for the Vaca Station energy services is not immediate. As such, we believe it is in the best interest of both CPV and the Commission to defer any work on the project until that time when the market need emerges. CPV Vacaville, LLC. hereby submits this request to withdraw, without prejudice, this project's Application for Certification for the CPV Vaca Station Power Plant Project (08-AFC-11).

We wish to thank you and the entire Commission for all efforts associated with the review and support of the development of our project and look forward to working with you in the future. CPV intends to retain site control under a long term lease option with the City of Vacaville so that the Project is well positioned to respond to the future energy needs of the Northern California energy market.
