I called Rich Montoya, the road maintenance supervisor of Contra Costa County, to follow up on our previous conversation. Rich inspected Bruns Road and recognized five pot holes along the road in the Contra Costa jurisdiction. He confirmed that these were recent and were not present in his last inspection three to four weeks prior. Rich stated that the road damage was most likely attributed to a spike in activity at the nearby Byron-Bethany Irrigation District. Rich could not identify a reason but only stated that there was an unusually high volume of water trucks coming out of the irrigation facility on Bruns Road. Rich has already put in a maintenance request for all five points of damage. Contra Costa County is taking on the repairs and could have them complete within one to two weeks.
