MEP is a 200-megawatt (MW) simple cycle power plant facility located in northeastern Alameda County, California.


**Modification Description:**

Petition submitted by Mariposa Energy, LLC, to install temporary water storage tanks in case of possible curtailment. With the modifications, the project will remain in compliance with Laws, Ordinances, Regulations and Standards, and reduce potential environmental impacts to a less than significant level.

On July 30, 2015, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project modifications pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Natural Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.

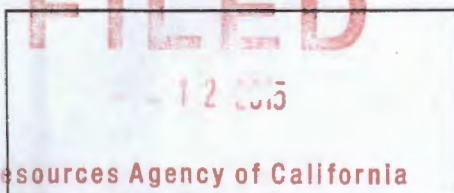
