Just want to clarify a couple of points. The SVEP project will not impact wetlands. As regards the drainage feature we discussed that lies just north of McLaughlin Road, the SVEP will not affect this feature in any way (and we'll be certain to monitor construction in this area so that construction equipment stays clear). You might have misunderstood my comments about the Inland Empire project's potential impacts to wetlands. I had mentioned to you that Inland constructed a pipeline and duct bank across this drainage feature, and placed transmission tower base in the edge of it. It was their impact that was in the 100s or 10ths of an acre, not Sun Valley's. For the Sun Valley Project, we will not affect this feature at all and so there will be no impact requiring notification of the Corps of Engineers.  We may wish to hold a conference call or meeting to talk this through, just so we're all thinking the same thing.
