Air Quality

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) filed its Revised Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC-R) for the Sun Valley Energy Project (SVEP) on February 1, 2008.


Staff is awaiting the completion of the Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC) from the SCAQMD, which is expected within the next 45 days, possibly by early April, 2008. Staff is expecting to publish the Final Staff Assessment (FSA) within 45 days of receipt of the FDOC from SCAQMD, perhaps as early as the middle of May, 2008. Evidentiary Hearings could take place in June, 2008, to be followed by the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision. Staff will incorporate requirements from the SCAQMD's FDOC into the FSA.

U. S. Army Corps of Engineers

Staff had requested that the applicant conduct additional consultations with the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) regarding the jurisdictional status of drainage features that the non-reclaimable wastewater pipeline will cross and the potential that pipeline construction would require a permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act. A letter from the USACE was filed on January 7, 2008, stating that the SVEP would not affect wetlands or waters of the United States and that the USACE would not require the applicant to obtain a Section 404 permit for the project.
