Subject: STATUS REPORT #10 FOR THE SUN VALLEY ENERGY PROJECT (05-AFC-3)

Dear Mr. Worl,

Pursuant to the terms of the Commission's Order Suspending Proceeding dated May 31, 2011, Valle Del Sol Energy, LLC submits Status Report #10 for the Sun Valley Energy Project. The Sun Valley Energy Project (SVEP) is a 500-megawatt natural gas-fired peaker plant that will be located in the City of Menifee, California. We believe SVEP represents an ideally-sited opportunity to add peaking generation to efficiently integrate renewable energy to the Los Angeles basin grid as it becomes necessary. The site is located on 50 acres of former farm land 30 yards southwest of the Valley Substation and will feature five General Electric LMS-100 gas turbines.

At this time, Valle Del Sol has demonstrated its ownership of all required VOC ERCs, however, is still challenged by the lack of available PM₁₀ and SO_x ERCs that is affecting the entire SCAQMD region. We will continue to monitor this issue and work with SCAQMD to assess all potential solutions. Valle Del Sol's affiliate's nearly identical Walnut Creek Energy Park (WCEP) was successful in Southern California Edison's 2008 power contract solicitation and in finding an ERC solution that allowed WCEP to advance to construction last spring. We greatly appreciated the Commission's assistance in that matter and plan to provide updates on any changes relating to the progress of SVEP.

Additionally, in prior communication, a question was raised regarding the status of the temporary railroad crossing application that Valle Del Sol submitted in 2008 to the Riverside County Transportation Commission. The purpose of this application is to provide additional site access during construction of the Project. We are currently evaluating the status of this matter and will provide the Commission with an update in our next report.
