

PROPOSED NEW POWER PLANT IN THE CITY OF RANCHO CUCAMONGA, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

The California Energy Commission has received an application for a permit to replace two generating units at the existing Etiwanda Generating Station, in Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino County. This project is called the San Gabriel Generating Station, or EGGS.

A portion of the Energy Commission's permitting process involves notifying citizens and addressing their concerns. We anticipate holding public workshops and hearings in the future, and we would like to notify representatives of the Native American community concerning the time and place of those public workshops. To help us do this, please provide (by fax, if possible) a current list of representatives of the Native American community who, to your knowledge, wish to be contacted concerning construction disturbances in their area. Please limit the list to those with traditional ties to San Bernardino County. We do not need any information concerning the location of sacred sites.
