SUBJECT: San Gabriel Generation Station Project, Application for Certification (07-AFC-2)

Dear Mr. Yeh:

Thank you for contacting the City of Rancho Cucamonga regarding an Application for Certification of the San Gabriel Generation Station Project (07-AFC-2) at a 17-acre site at 8996 Etiwanda Avenue.

It was a pleasure to speak to you today regarding the project. Thank you for informing the City of the project's status and noting that additional environmental documents will be forthcoming along with opportunities to review and comment on the project. Per our discussion, the City is interested in receiving any additional public notices, environmental reports, plans, and other pertinent documents relating to the project.

The April 24, 2007 letter from Mr. Roger Johnson stated that an EIR would not be prepared and that instead various environmental documents would be prepared instead. Since the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) process has not been incorporated in this project, the City is concerned about being provided an adequate time period to respond. The City is requesting adequate time frames that are at the minimum equal to the time periods for circulation of CEQA documents. In addition, the City would like to inquire if the project would need to comply with the California Public Utilities Commission General Order 131-D, which requires CEQA clearance.

Although the City is in the process of reviewing the preliminary documents, some initial concerns are as follows:

- o Increased noise;
- o Impacts on air quality; and
- o Impacts to public services (Fire).

Since we are in the process of conducting a comprehensive review of the project, we look forward to the opportunity to comment on the project during the upcoming comment period. Please feel free to contact me at (909) 477-2750 with any questions.
