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

SUSPENSION STATUS REPORT NUMBER 8**

In accordance with the Committee Order Suspending Proceeding dated July 16, 2010, the applicant in this proceeding, San Gabriel Power Generation, LLC ("San Gabriel"), submits its suspension status report number 8. San Gabriel is seeking certification for the San Gabriel Generating Station, a 696 megawatt natural gas-fired electricity generating facility to be located in Rancho Cucamonga, California within the jurisdiction of the South Coast Air Quality Management District ("SCAQMD").

San Gabriel requested the current suspension of this proceeding due to permitting difficulties associated with the unavailability within the SCAQMD of certain emission offsets needed to satisfy applicable SCAQMD rules. Those permitting difficulties still exist and emission offsets are still not available for the San Gabriel Project. San Gabriel therefore filed a Request for Additional Project Suspension in this proceeding on April 27, 2011. The reasons for San Gabriel's request are explained in more detail in that filing.
