Thank you for your letter dated, February 26, 2009, seeking information regarding the proposed Vaca Station Project by Competitive Power Ventures Vacaville, LLC to license a power plan located at the intersection of Lewis and Fry Roads in Solano County, California. Based on the information provided, the Rumsey Band of Wintun Indians, of California is not aware of any known cultural resources on this site. However, as the project progresses, if cultural resources or Native American human remains are found, we have a process for handling such an occurrence. It is always recommended that tribal monitors be present for any studies or ground moving activities.
