

On behalf of CPV Vacaville, LLC (“Applicant”) and pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order issued on March 23, 2009, we submit this Status Report No. 1 for the CPV Vaca Station Power Plant Project (08-AFC-11) (“Project”).

I. DISCOVERY STATUS

On March 5, 2009, the Applicant received Staff’s Data Requests Set 1. Applicant provided timely responses to the Data Requests in a submittal docketed on April 6, 2009.

On April 22, 2009, Applicant participated in the Data Response & Issue Resolution Staff Workshop. Based on discussions with Cultural Resources Staff, Applicant agreed to provide additional information about evaluating the historical geomorphology of the Project site and linears. Based on discussions with Air Quality Staff, Applicant agreed to provide the following additional information:

- Explanation of how the Project’s proposed start-up and shut-down technology achieves a similar level of emissions reductions as technology proposed for other proposed combined-cycle power plants currently being considered by the Energy Commission.
- Regular status updates of Applicant’s efforts to obtain emission offsets for the Project, as discussed below.

- Proposed language for excursions and tuning, and historical information on the extent to which other projects have availed themselves of such provisions.
- Cumulative air quality modeling analysis.

Applicant was informed at the Data Response & Issue Resolution Staff Workshop that Staff will submit initial subject area Data Requests by May 1, 2009. It is Applicant's understanding these will constitute the final initial subject area Data Requests (i.e., new Data Requests based on Staff's initial review of a subject area). In order to stay on pace with the Committee Schedule established on March 23, 2009, Applicant believes there has been adequate time since the AFC was deemed complete on January 23, 2009 for Staff to complete its initial evaluation of the AFC subject areas.

II. EMISSION OFFSETS

In December 2008, Applicant submitted a confidential filing to the Energy Commission that described the pool of potential sources of emission reduction credits (ERCs) that Applicant had identified. As described in the filing, the list did not represent the proposed ERCs that would be used for offsets and mitigation but instead represented the pool of ERCs from which mitigation was expected to be drawn. Since that time, Applicant has identified additional potential sources of offsets, as discussed at the April 22, 2009 Data Response & Issue Resolution Staff Workshop. Applicant continues to identify and negotiate with potential suppliers of offsets. Once the mitigation package has been finalized, it will be promptly submitted to the Yolo-Solano Air Quality Management District and the Energy Commission. In addition, Applicant will continue to provide the Energy Commission with regular updates on the status of its ERC strategy.


