Willow Pass Generating Station Project (08-AFC-6) STATUS REPORT 3 Subject:

> Pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order dated December 31, 2008, the following is staff's Status Report 2 for the proposed Willow Pass Generating Station (WPGS).

Current Issues and Activities for Resolution

Staff filed Set 2 data requests on April 28, 2009, in the areas of Biological Resources, Socioeconomics, Soil and Water Resources, Transmission System Engineering, and Waste Management. Written responses to these data requests were filed with the Energy Commission on May 28, 2009 with outstanding responses in the areas of Biological Resources, Transmission System Engineering and Waste Management. Responses to the remaining outstanding data requests should be filed by mid-June. Staff does not anticipate the need for a Data Response workshop given the clarity of the responses received to date.

Staff has met with US Fish and Wildlife Service and CA Department of Fish and Game in early May to discuss the potential for nitrogen deposition impacts from this project and coordinate efforts to review the project. As a follow-up to the discussions, staff from US Fish and Wildlife Service, CA Department of Fish and Game and the Energy Commission have scheduled a site visit to the Antioch Dunes National Wildlife Refuge in mid-June to tour and familiarize themselves with the wildlife area.

The Bay Area Air Quality Management District's (BAAQMD) Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC) has not yet been released for the project. Staff contacted the BAAQMD and understands the release of the PDOC is scheduled for mid-late July 2009. Staff will complete the air quality analysis of the PSA approximately 30 days after the PDOC is released.

Schedule

As a result of the delay in the PDOC release date, staff anticipates the publication of the PSA approximately thirty (30) days after the PDOC is released, which would tentatively schedule publication of the PSA in mid-late August. Staff's recommendation for a revised schedule is as follows:
