COMMENTS:

Staff spoke with Mike Kissell to determine whether the City of Industry has General Plan Elements or City Ordinances that address the subject of cultural resources. Mr. Kissell confirmed that no City LORS address the subject of cultural resources.

Staff also asked about ground disturbance following demolition of the warehouse that now sits on the site of the proposed WCEP. Staff expressed concern that WCEP's cultural resources consultant had advised that the area where WCEP would be located was sensitive for cultural resources. Mr. Kissell said that information obtained during background research for numerous EIRs indicated that the area was not a location where discovery of cultural resources was likely.

Mr. Kissell also explained that a great deal of disturbance had occurred to the land under the warehouse during its construction. He characterized the location as greatly disturbed. He said that there was no plan to have a cultural resources monitor on site during ground disturbance caused by demolition of the warehouse. If cultural resources are discovered, then the City will obtain a monitor. Mr. Kissell stressed that the warehouse would be demolished whether or not the power plant is built.
