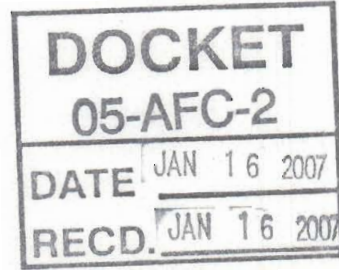

Description

On December 12, 2006 I performed a supplemental cultural resources inventory, at the request of Doug Davy/CH2M HILL, in support of the Walnut Creek Energy Park Project. Specifically, I surveyed two additional transmission line alignments for tie-in to the nearby Walnut Substation, identified as Option 1 and Option 2 on the attached Figure 1. The Option 1 alignment runs from southeast to northwest from the plant site along the north side of the adjacent Union Pacific Railroad. The Option 2 alignment runs from southeast to northwest along the south side of the adjacent Union Pacific Railroad. Both segments are approximately 1100 feet in length. The project area is in the City of Industry, Los Angeles County, California.

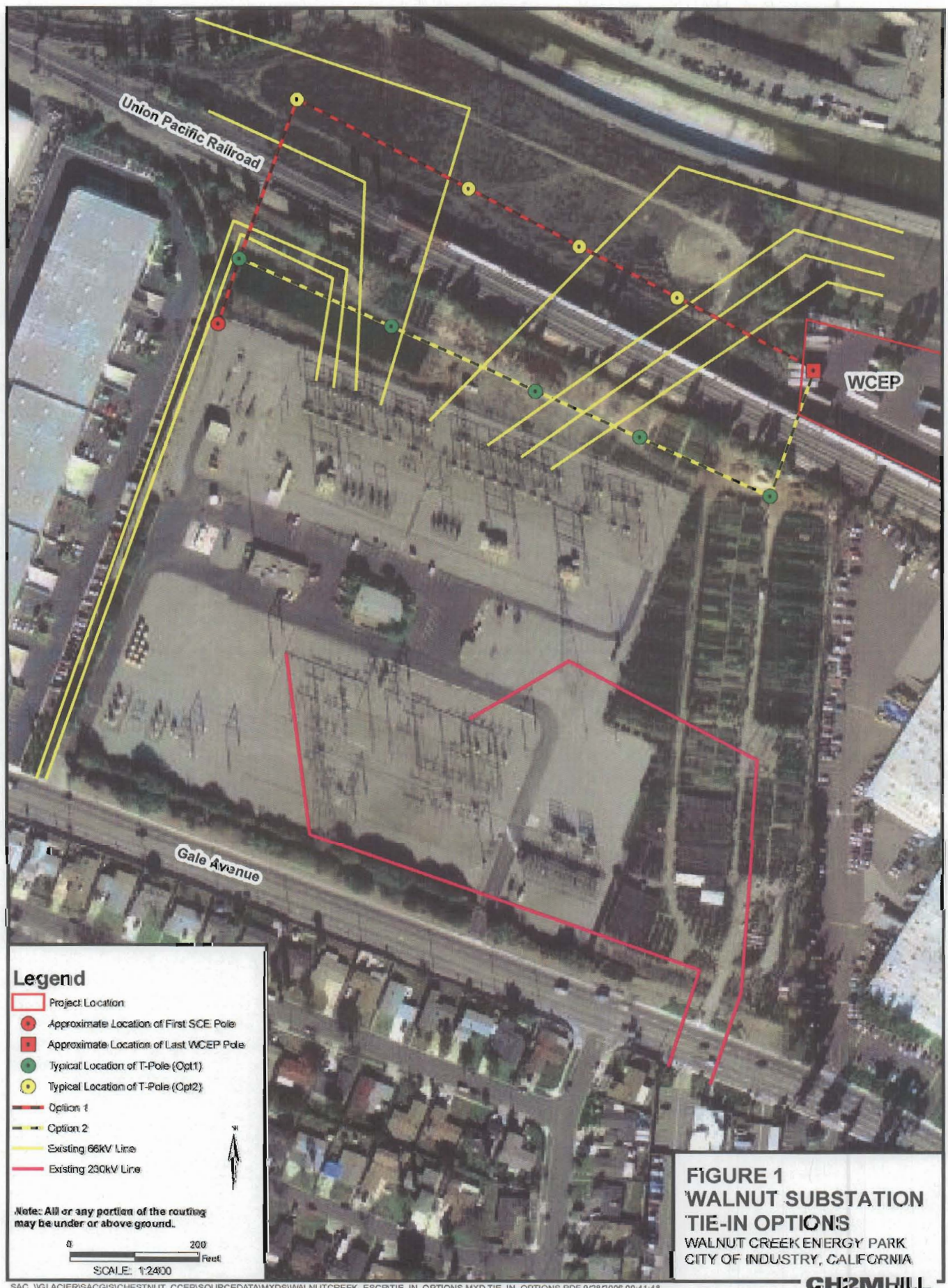
Using pedestrian transects spaced no more than 10 meters apart, I surveyed at least a 100-foot corridor for the Option 1 and Option 2 alignments. The railroad right-of-way was not part of the survey area.

Conditions

Ground visibility was approximately 20%, obscured by various weeds. The Option 2 corridor is covered with gravel pathways and various potted plants and the entire ground surface has been heavily disturbed. Bare spots were carefully examined for any signs of cultural material. Weather was sunny and warm.

Results

No cultural resources were encountered during the survey. Since no objects or sites were located, no site records were prepared. Both the Union Pacific Railroad and the Walnut Substation were previously recorded and evaluated.
