

## PROPOSED NEW POWER PLANT IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, NEAR THE TOWN OF VICTORVILLE

The California Energy Commission has received an application for a permit to construct a new, hybrid, solar-natural-gas-fired power plant southwest of the town of Victorville.

A portion of the Energy Commission's permitting process involves notifying citizens and addressing their concerns. We anticipate holding public workshops and hearings in the future, and we would like to notify representatives of the Native American community concerning the time and place of those public workshops.
