APPLICANT'S COMMENTS ON ERRATA AND REVISIONS TO THE PRESIDING MEMBER'S PROPOSED DECISION

The City of Victorville ("Applicant") thanks the Committee for its diligence in preparing the Errata and Revisions to the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision issued June 30, 2008 ("Errata"). Applicant notes that a few matters were not reflected in the Errata and respectfully requests that the Committee address the following items:

- 1. PMPD Page 113, AQ-SC1: The Verification for AQ-SC1 requires Applicant to submit information on the on-site Air Quality Construction Mitigation Manager (AQCMP) no later than 60 days prior to the start of ground disturbance. In Applicant's Comments on the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision submitted June 13, 2008 ("Applicant's Comments") and at the hearing on June 17, 2008, Applicant requested that this compliance due date be changed to 30 days prior to site mobilization (August 1, 2008 under current schedule). Staff did not object to this request.
- 2. PMPD Page 240, CUL-1: Staff agreed to change the compliance due dates in (1) CUL-1, Verification 1, to 45 days prior to start of ground disturbance; (2) CUL-1, Verification 3, to 20 days prior to start of ground disturbance; and (3) CUL-1, Verification 5, to 10 days prior to start of ground disturbance. (FSA Addendum at CR pp. 1-2.) In Applicant's Comments and at the June 17, 2008 hearing, Applicant requested that this compliance due date be changed to 30 days prior to ground disturbance. This request was not granted; however, the Errata does not include changes to the compliance due dates in CUL-1, Verifications 1, 3, and 5 that previously were obtained and noted in the FSA Addendum.
- 3. PMPD Page 302, NOISE-4: Staff modified NOISE-4 to read, in relevant part, as follows: The project design and implementation shall include noise mitigation measures adequate to ensure that operation of the project will not cause noise levels due solely to plant operation to exceed an average of 39 dBA Leq measured at monitoring location ML2, the residence one mile west of the project site. No new pure tone components may be caused by the project. No single piece of equipment shall be allowed to stand out as a source of noise that draws legitimate complaints. (FSA Addendum at Noise p. 1.)

- 4. PMPD Page 352, VIS-1: Staff modified VIS-1 by deleting condition D in its entirety ("One set of 11" x 17" color photo simulations at life size scale of the proposed treatment for project structures, including structures treated during manufacture, from the Key Observation Points".) (FSA Addendum at VR p. 1; Prehearing Conference Transcript 15:24-25; 16:1-8.)
- 5. Item no. 11 in the Errata states that:

Condition of Certification **BIO-12**, third sentence of paragraph 14, has been modified to read as follows: All translocated animals found during a dawn to dusk search will be monitored monthly to include two consecutive spring seasons, after which transmitters will be removed.

This should read:

Condition of Certification BIO-12 has been modified as requested by Staff in its comment on the Presiding Member's Proposed Decision, except that the third sentence of paragraph 14 shall read as follows: All translocated animals found during a dawn to dusk search will be monitored monthly to include two consecutive spring seasons, after which transmitters will be removed.
