As a result of the burning of natural gas in the boilers and diesel fuel from the emergency engines, emissions from the proposed project also contains some pollutants that are considered toxic under SCAQMD Rule 1401-New Source Review of Toxic Air Contaminants. Therefore, a health risk assessment was performed for this project. The health risk assessment uses health protective assumptions in estimating actual risk to an individual person.
