

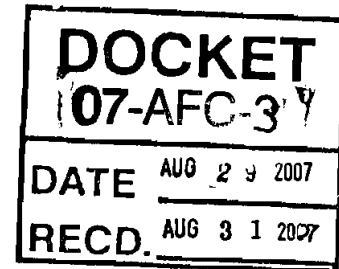

I. INTRODUCTION

On June 25, 2007, the CPV Sentinel, LLC submitted an Application for Certification for the CPV Sentinel Energy project. The proposed 850-megawatt natural gas-fired plant will be located in unincorporated Riverside County, adjacent to the City of Palm Springs northern city limits.

II. SUMMARY OF HEARING

At a regularly scheduled business meeting on August 29, 2007, the Commission accepted the AFC as complete and appointed a Committee to preside over the CPV Sentinel project Application for Certification proceedings pursuant to Public Resources Code section 25211 and Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1204.

III. ORDER

Having been accepted as complete on August 29, 2007, under Public Resources Code section 25522, the Application for Certification for the CPV Sentinel project is deemed filed as of that date. The statutory timeline for a final decision under Public Resources Code section 25540.6 shall begin as of August 29, 2007, the filing date. The Commission hereby appoints **James D. Boyd** as Presiding Member and **Jackalyne Pfannenstiel** as Associate Member to serve as a Committee to preside over the CPV Sentinel, LLC Application for Certification proceedings.
