
Coachella Valley Economic Partnership Helping Innovative Companies Expand/Relocate to The Coachella Valley.

Dear Board Members:

The Coachella Valley Economic Partnership (CVEP) supports the proposed CPV Sentinel standby power plant to be located in the north-western Coachella Valley.

CVEP is the regional economic development agency for the Coachella Valley. Our membership includes the nine cities of the Coachella Valley, the County of Riverside and 120 private businesses. Our work to attract business to the region as well as to assist existing businesses with expansion will be enhanced with the addition of the proposed CPV Sentinel project.

We believe that a reliable supply of power — which includes back-up power — is a key component of sustainable economic growth. The proposed project will bring important economic benefits in the form of new revenue and new jobs to our region.
