HECA Neighbors

HECA Neighbors attended the CEC Water workshop in Sacramento Feb. 20, 2013. We appreciate that the CEC is continuing to seek answers to several questions that were unresolved at the workshop.

HECA Neighbors made a presentation to the Kern County Board of Supervisors Feb 26, 2013. Our issues were signed by nearly 150 folks, all neighbors to the proposed HECA plant. Our issues were submitted for docketing with the CEC. The BOS meeting was very well attended and many people spoke of concerns.

A hearing is scheduled for April 2, 2013 over HECA at the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District. HECA Neighbors requests the CEC please attend this meeting to understand the degree of interest from the public. A repeated concern from the audience at the Board of Sup meeting was the air we will be breathing after HECA cranks up. People question how the air credits are supposed to ensure cleaner, safer air. Staff from the SJVAPCD answered that it is complicated and very difficult to explain. But the SJVAPCD has determined that buying offsets will ensure a net air quality benefit. We appreciate the CEC helping the public, with the most pollution challenged air in the nation, to get real answers.
