Purpose of Prehearing Conference

The Prehearing Conference is a public forum where the Committee will assess the parties' readiness for an evidentiary hearing, identify areas of agreement or dispute, and discuss the remaining schedule and procedures necessary to conclude the review of the Application for Certification. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20 § 1718.5.)

At the Prehearing Conference, Intervenors shall present their respective positions regarding Air Quality and identify those issues that have been resolved and those that are disputed which will require adjudication. Intervenors shall also identify proposed witnesses, as well as the time required for direct testimony and/or cross-examination. (Applicant and Staff have already submitted their Prehearing Conference Statements).

Local, state, and federal governmental agencies may participate at the Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary Hearing, as necessary. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20 § 1714.5.) Elected officials and members of the public may present public comments at these events and/or submit written comments to the Energy Commission's Docket Unit. Please include "Docket No. 07-AFC-3" on any written comments.

Prehearing Conference Statements

To facilitate the process, Intervenors shall serve and file a **Prehearing Conference Statement**. The statements shall be received by the other parties and the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS-15, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, by **no later than 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 1, 2010**. Intervenors shall e-mail their statements to the Hearing Officer as well as to the Docket Unit and the parties as indicated on the Proof-of-Service list.

FAILURE TO FILE A TIMELY PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT MAY PRECLUDE A PARTY FROM PARTICIPATING AT THIS HEARING.

Each statement shall set forth:

- 1. The Air Quality issues that are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing;
- 2. The Air Quality issues that are not complete and not yet ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing, and the reasons therefor;
- 3. The Air Quality issues that remain disputed and require adjudication, and the precise nature of the dispute for each topic;
- 4. The identity of each witness sponsored by each party (note: witnesses must have professional expertise in the discipline of their testimony); the topic area(s) which each witness will present; a brief summary of the testimony to be offered by each witness; qualifications of each witness; and the time required to present direct testimony by each witness;
- 5. Air Quality issues upon which a party desires to cross-examine witnesses, a summary of the scope of each such cross-examination, and the time desired for each such cross-examination;
- 6. Any proposed modifications to the proposed Conditions of Certification listed in the Final Staff Analysis (FSA) Air Quality section based upon enforceability, ease of comprehension, and consistency with the evidence.

WITNESS TESTIMONY AND EXHIBIT LISTS

Intervenors shall serve and file an exhibit list along with their expert witness testimony. Testimony and exhibit lists shall be received by the other parties and the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS-15, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, by <u>no later than 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 15, 2010</u>. Intervenors shall e-mail their statements to the Hearing Officer as well as to the Docket Unit and the parties as indicated on the

Proof-of-Service list. Copies shall be served on the Hearing Officer in Microsoft WORD format.

Intervenor's list identifying exhibits and declarations it intends to offer into evidence shall adhere to following section on formats.

Formats for Presenting Evidence

At the Evidentiary Hearing each party shall be prepared to present evidence on each of the Air Quality issues in the sequence established in the FSA. The Intervenors **shall provide copies** of all documentary and written testimonial evidence **in the following formats to all parties**, the Committee and the Hearing Adviser.
