Re: Fw: Traffic Question Re: Follow up Questions to Data Responses for Starwood PowerAngela - Our Mendota School District Contact Mr. Ralph Meza said that the school bus, picks up an approximate range of 18-25 students at the Panoche stop near the existing substation. Apparently, there are some minor roads coming from the farms and farmworker/parents leave their kids at the "staging area" where the school bus picks them up. The student numbers are the observed range of bus riders as some kids might sometimes get dropped at the schools on some days, or have doctors appointments or sports activities.

The findings is that even though the apartments and residences across the street will be gone, there will still be a substantial number of students coming from other sources. It is recommended that the proponent and its contractor to coordinate with the school district regarding potential conflicts with planned construction activities at or near the existing bus stop. One option that need to be considered is to relocate

the "staging area" (bus pick up) further away (more like east , less traffic) from the construction site.
