Notice of Staff Data Request and Issue Workshop for the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System Project (07-AFC-5)

The California Energy Commission (Energy Commission), and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will conduct a workshop to discuss staff data requests, and issues of concern for the proposed Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System (ISEGS) project. The applicant, Solar Partners I, LLC; Solar Partners II, LLC; Solar Partners VI, LLC; Solar Partners VIII, LLC, (referred to as Solar Partners, LLC) requests that this project be developed in three phases. The proposed project will be a 400-megawatt solar thermal electric power generating system. The project's technology would include heliostat mirror fields focusing solar energy on power tower receivers generating steam for running turbine generators. Related facilities would include administrative buildings, transmission lines, a substation, gas lines, water lines, steam lines, and well water pumps. The proposed project would be developed entirely in the Mojave Desert region of San Bernardino County, California.

Purpose

The purpose of the data requests, and issue workshop is to discuss data requests published by the Energy Commission and BLM agency staffs for the ISEGS project on December 11, 2007, and responses to the data requests. This workshop will help agency staff, and other interested parties to more fully understand the proposed project impacts,

develop mitigation measures, and where necessary, to protect the environment, and public. The review of this proposed solar project is in the discovery phase of a joint state, and federal agency environmental, and engineering review proceeding. Following this workshop, the Committee, comprised of two Energy Commission Commissioners, will conduct an Informational Hearing and Site Visit at this same location. The Informational Hearing has been separately noticed.

Background

On August 30, 2007, Solar Partners, LLC filed an Application for Certification (AFC) with the Energy Commission to develop the ISEGS project. On October 31, 2007, the Energy Commission accepted the AFC as complete and ready for review in a joint agency proceeding. Solar Partners, LLC, is proposing to develop the ISEGS project on public lands managed by the BLM, thus requiring a right-of-way from the BLM. The Energy Commission has the authority to license thermal power plants 50 megawatts or larger in California. The joint agency review will eliminate duplication, and is an attempt to streamline the process. The Energy Commission is responsible for the California Environmental Quality Act review, while the BLM is responsible for the National Environmental Policy Act aspects of the proceeding.

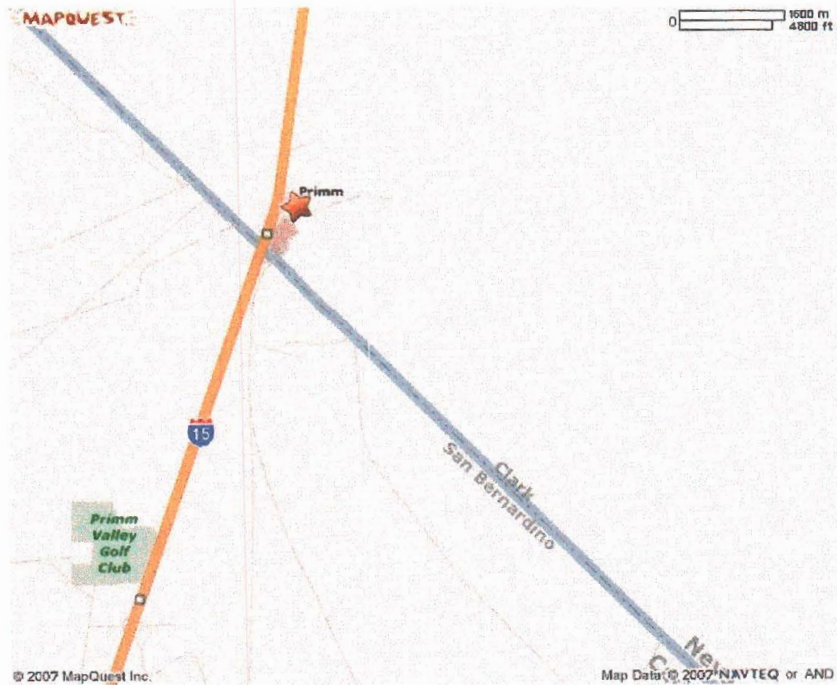
