INTRODUCTION

On August 31, 2007, Solar Partners, LLC, submitted an Application for Certification for the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System project. The proposed 400-megawatt solar thermal plant will be located in San Bernardino County in the Mojave Desert near the Nevada border.

II. SUMMARY OF HEARING

At a special business meeting held on October 31, 2007, the Commission accepted the AFC as complete and appointed a Committee to preside over the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System project Application for Certification proceedings pursuant to Public Resources Code section 25211 and Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1204.

III. ORDER

Having been accepted as complete on October 31, 2007, under Public Resources Code section 25522(b), the Application for Certification for the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System project is deemed filed as of that date. The statutory timeline for a final decision under Public Resources Code section 25540.6 shall begin as of October 31, 2007, the filing date. The Commission hereby appoints **Jeffrey Byron** as Presiding Member and **James Boyd** as Associate Member to serve as a Committee to preside over the Solar Partners, LLC's, Application for Certification proceedings.
