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SECOND PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT OF INTERVENOR BASIN AND RANGE WATCH

- 1. The topic areas that are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing:

 BRW is prepared to proceed to evidentiary hearing.
- 2. The topic areas that are not complete and not yet ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing, and the reasons therefore:

Basin and Range Watch understands that the area of Visual Resources remains unresolved. The record is incomplete in this area, as views from Clark Mountain within Mojave National Preserve, and Mesquite and Stateline Wilderness Areas could be significantly impacted by the project.

3. The topic areas that remain disputed and require adjudication, and the precise nature of the dispute for each topic:

Visual Resources: As stated above, Basin and Range Watch understands that further information concerning the significant impacts, including cumulative impacts, to surrounding recreational areas need to be entered into the record, particularly how the project is viewed from popular local Wilderness Areas and

Mojave National Preserve.

Biological Resources: The rich biodiversity of the project site, including many rare and sensitive species, makes it inappropriate for development of such a land-intensive project. Areas of dispute include the impacts to desert tortoise, local breeding bird habitats and migratory routes, and how these might be affected by project design, and various mitigation/minimization measures for such sensitive species as Gila monster which may inhabit the site.

4. Witnesses, Topic Areas, Testimony and Exhibits:

Basin and Range Watch will sponsor the testimony of Laura Cunningham. Cunningham will testify on the proposed project's impacts on visual resources. Such testimony should take no more than 5 minutes. Exhibit #800 is a photographic database, including photographs showing the view of the project site from nearby Wilderness Areas and Mojave National Preserve.

5. Topic areas upon which a party desires to cross-examine witnesses, a summary of the scope of such cross-examination, and the time desired for such cross-examination:

Basin and Range Watch reserves the right and opportunity for brief cross examinations of areas that may be adjudicated using witness testimony.

6. Proposals for briefing deadlines, vacation schedules, and other scheduling matters:

Given the volume of resource issues in this case and their significance, Basin and Range Watch requests that the opening briefs following the evidentiary hearings not be due any earlier than three weeks after the close of the evidentiary hearings.
