Re: Draft Desert Tortoise Translocation/Relocation Plan for the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System, 07-AFC- 5

Dear Mr. Kessler:

On behalf of the Sierra Club's San Gorgonio Chapter, this letter is to comment on the Draft Desert Tortoise Translocation/Relocation Plan submitted on March 19, 2009 for the Ivanpah Solar Electric Generating System (ISEGS) Project in Supplemental Data Response Set 2A.

We concur with the conclusion set forth in your letter of April 29 to Mr. Woolard of Solar Partners that additional information and details are necessary to an adequate Translocation/Relocation Plan. Any take of the State- and Federally-protected desert tortoise at the proposed ISEGS site must be minimized. We likewise support the specific comments on the Draft Translocation/Relocation Plan made by staff, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and the California Department of Fish and Game. The comments accurately reflect what must be incorporated in the final plan to reduce further threats to the desert tortoise.

We request that staff incorporate into the FSA, not only the specifics of the Translocation/Relocation Plan, but the consensus of the Desert Tortoise Science Advisory Committee (SAC) at its meeting of March 13, 2009 that "..translocation is fraught with long-term uncertainties...and should not be considered lightly as a management option." The SAC recommended that: "When considered, translocation should be part of a strategic population augmentation program, targeted toward depleted populations in areas containing 'good' habitat". The SAC further recommends that any translocations should be accompanied by research "to study the effectiveness or success of the translocation relative to changes in land use, management, or environmental condition."
