Tony called and updated me on the fire situation in Fallbrook. Over 280 structures burned and the City is in the process of clean up. In addition, the fire burned the SR 76 corridor, including the project site, and major water lines under the control of Rainbow Water District. He inquired about the workshop date and I informed him I have postponed the workshop because of the issue of a new source of project water, and until CEC staff have received the addendum to the project, and had time to review and issue a new set of data requests, (if necessary), the workshop would be postponed until at least 6 weeks.

Tony said he would be forwarding to the CEC copies of environmental reports that had been submitted to the SCH on projects along the SR 76 corridor, within close proximity to the Orange Grove Energy project. He said the environmental documents need to be reviewed by CEC staff, as they demonstrate cumulative effects. I expect these documents to be mailed to the CEC this week.

Tony also mentioned Enviropel Energy would be filing an AFC on the Fallbrook Renewable Energy project sometime in early November. I contacted management to inform them of the intent of Enviropel Energy.
