# **Purpose of Prehearing Conference**

The Prehearing Conference is a public forum where the Committee will assess the parties' readiness for an evidentiary hearing, identify areas of agreement or dispute, and discuss the remaining schedule and procedures necessary to conclude the certification process. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1718.5.)

At the Prehearing Conferences, all parties (Staff, Applicant, and Intervenors) shall present their respective positions regarding: the substantive topic areas ready for evidentiary hearing; those topics that require further analysis, including the nature of, and time frame for, any such analysis; the topic areas that have been resolved; and the topic areas that are disputed and require adjudication. The parties shall also identify proposed witnesses, as well as the time required for direct testimony and/or cross-examination.

# **Prehearing Conference Statements**

Each party is **ORDERED** to serve and file a **PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT** containing all of the information described below. The parties shall e-mail and/or mail their statements to the Hearing Officer, to the parties as indicated on the proof of service list, and submit both e-mail and paper copy to the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS-4, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, so as to be received **NO LATER than 4 P.M. on Thursday, May 13, 2010**. Each statement shall specify:

- 1. The topic areas that are complete and ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing;
- 2. The topic areas that are not complete and not yet ready to proceed to evidentiary hearing, and the reasons therefor;
- 3. The topic areas that remain disputed and require adjudication, and the precise nature of the dispute for each topic;
- 4. The identity of each witness sponsored by each party (note: expert witnesses must demonstrate professional expertise in their area(s) of testimony); the topic area(s) which each witness will present; a brief summary of the testimony to be offered by each witness; qualifications of each witness; and the time required to present direct testimony by each witness;

# Format for Presenting Written Testimonial and Documentary Evidence

### Petitions to Intervene to Become a Formal Party

The Energy Commission's Decision on the Ridgecrest Solar Power Project will be based on the official evidentiary record developed at the Evidentiary Hearing. Only formal parties (Applicant, Staff, and Intervenors) may present evidence and crossexamine witnesses at the Evidentiary Hearing. Public comment may not, by itself, support a finding or conclusion in the Decision but the Committee may consider it to the extent it can supplement formal written or oral testimony sponsored by a party.

Anyone with an appropriate interest in the Project may file a Petition to Intervene and become a formal party. At the Evidentiary Hearing, a formal party may offer testimony and documentary evidence and cross-examine witnesses. A formal party must also comply with Committee orders, procedures, and filing requirements, and is subject to discovery and having its own witnesses cross-examined by other parties.

**The DEADLINE to file a Petition to Intervene in this case is SATURDAY, APRIL 17, 2010.** (20 Cal. Code Regs., § 1003.) Petitions filed after that date and time extensions for new Intervenors to review case materials may be granted only upon a showing by the Petitioner that extraordinary circumstances made it impossible to file by the deadline, in the judgment of the Committee.

# COMMITTEE SCHEDULING ORDER

# Background

On September 1, 2009, the Energy Commission received an Application for Certification (AFC) from Solar Millennium LLC, (Applicant) to construct a solar thermal power plant facility in the high northern Mojave Desert in northeastern Kern County, California, about five miles southwest of the City of Ridgecrest, California.

The Energy Commission found the AFC data adequate on November 18, 2009, and assigned a Committee to conduct proceedings on the AFC. The Committee held a public Site Visit and Informational Hearing at Ridgecrest City Hall on January 5, 2010, to discuss the review process and to identify issues that could affect the schedule. A Committee Schedule issued shortly thereafter.

On March 26, 2010, Commission Staff issued a Staff Assessment/Draft Environmental Impact Statement in this matter. As a result, the Committee has further revised the Committee Schedule to identify events that must occur in order to complete the certification process. The Committee encourages the parties to consider the dates in the attached schedule as final deadlines and endeavor to complete the tasks ahead of these dates. Some deadlines are estimates contingent upon reviews to be conducted by federal, state, and local agencies.

### **Status Reports and Status Conferences**

As specified in the prior Scheduling Order, the Committee favors the elimination of unnecessary tasks, thereby allowing the parties to focus on resolution of issues and timely preparation of necessary documents. Accordingly, the Committee **orders** the parties to work with diligence to meet the scheduled deadlines. It is **further ordered** that the parties promptly inform the Committee via memo, e-mail, or telephone contact with the Hearing Adviser, of anything causing inability to meet a deadline. Any such communications shall be promptly docketed as appropriate.

The Committee continues to encourage the parties to request a Status Conference whenever needed. In order to provide sufficient notice, the Committee asks that requests for status conferences be submitted to the Hearing Adviser at least 15 days prior to the proposed date for the status conference. In order to conserve time and resources, the Committee will allow remote attendance at any status conference.
