SOLAR MILLENNIUM'S ISSUES STATEMENT FOR FEBRUARY 24 STATUS CONFERENCE

In order to provide recommendations to the Committee concerning the processing of the Ridgecrest Solar Power Project (RSPP) Application For Certification (AFC), Solar Millennium has prepared this outline of issues as directed by the Committee Notice of Status Conference that might affect the schedule for processing the project. As the Committee has noted the purpose of the Status Conference should be to resolve issues that may prevent the RSPP from being processed expeditiously in order to reach a Decision that would allow ARRA funding to be obtained. With that goal in mind, the following is a list of issues that Solar Millennium believes would be important to discuss at the Status Conference.

I. Biology Mitigation

- a. Staff has suggested that the applicant must propose mitigation. After several meeting with the agencies, we have failed to receive a consensus. Therefore we are preparing a mitigation plan for the Commission to consider. The mitigation plan will be filed next week and will contain the following elements. We urge the Committee to encourage Staff to prepare the SA/DEIS with its own mitigation proposal. The issue can then be resolved in workshops after the SA/DEIS.
 - Desert Tortoise We propose mitigation ratios ranging from 3:1 to 1:1 depending on the habitat value. In addition, we have prepared a series of plans including the translocation/relocation plan and worker training programs that will further reduce impacts to Desert Tortoise.
 - ii. Mohave Ground Squirrel The redesigned project allows connectivity for the species. In addition, we propose mitigation

- ratios of 5:1 where required by the West Mojave Plan and other mitigation rations appropriate for the habitat.
- b. We will mitigate through the in lieu fee program if established, through land acquisition, or a combination of the two, depending on the acceptability of the fee program, availability of land, etc. Given the timing of the expected in lieu fee program, the SA/DEIS may continue to be processed as this program is developed. We will continue to explore traditional land acquisition during this period.
- II. Water Mitigation
 - We have proposed a Water Offset Program that has a menu of options but commit to a condition that requires 215 AFY to be offset and demonstrated
- IV. Drainage
 - a. Redesign avoids potential for flooding
- V. Schedule

Solar Millennium looks forward to a productive Status Conference on February 24, 2010 and remains open to suggestions regarding the schedule that allow the project to move expeditiously while not requiring it to give up its right to disagree with Staff.
