Dear Mr. Blevins,

I write to reiterate my opposition to the proposed Eastshore Energy Power Plant(Eastshore) in Hayward, California.

I am encouraged that the preliminary staff assessment did not recommend certification of the project, and am advised that further public comments are invited and a final decision is ahead.

I live approximately ½ mile downwind of the proposed plant. I am surrounded by single family homes an elementary school, a junior high school and a large community college. Between me and the proposed plant are a large apartment complex another large single family residential area, three(that I know of) nursing homes, a large alcohol recovery center and (almost in the shadow of the proposed plant) a business college and a school of chiropractics.

I don't understand why they would try and place a high pollution facility in this area. I'm sure that there are communities that would welcome this kind of development but not here. Relatively clean air is about all we have left of what I understand was at one time a beautiful area.
